

General Overview

Each Awana ministry is broken into three general areas:

- Game Time
- Handbook Time
- Large Group Time

Game Time is designed to be "fun with a purpose". Awana games are designed to promote a team atmosphere that every child can enjoy regardless of their athletic ability.

In **Handbook Time**, children are encouraged to memorize scripture and are taught how God's word applies to our daily lives. Children are rewarded for their work in memorizing scripture by badges and awards, and by Awana Bucks they can use in the Awana Store, where they can buy all kinds of cool prizes!
